<p>* This rate represents a blended rate originally negotiated with this client. Attorneys and paralegals billed at the same rate. The normal or customary billing rates for attorneys with Mapother & Mapother, P.S.C. ranges from \$145-\$185 per hour for attorneys and \$65 per hour for paralegals. \$3,448.50 of the total \$9,642.50 (35.76%) requested in this application is for work done by paralegals. 64.24% of the work was done by attorneys. Assuming that the attorneys who billed work on these matters would have billed their time at the customary rate of \$145 per hour, the weighted/blended rate represented by this application would have been \$116.39 per hour [$35.76\% \times \\$65/\text{hr} = \\$23.24/\text{hr}$ $64.24\% \times \\$145/\text{hr} = 93.15/\text{hr}$. $\\$23.24 + 93.15 = \\116.39]. Therefore the fee requested by this application is less than the customary fee that could have otherwise been charged to this client.</p>				

Additional Statements relative to First and Final
Application of Mapother & Mapother, P.S.C.
Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §327

1. This Court has jurisdiction over this application pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §330, 28 U.S.C. §1334, this being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §157.
2. The subject Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Petition was filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware on November 15, 2002.
3. Pursuant to the Court's Order dated December 18, 2002, Docket Number 271, Exhibit A of Jointly Administered Case No. 02-13396 (PJW), the applicant was retained to continue to provide legal services to this Debtor.
4. The legal services provided to this Debtor were representing it in state courts for the collection of consumer debts and for replevin/possession of personal property securing loans made and/or financed by the Debtor. Applicant also defended counterclaims filed against the Debtor in those courts. Applicant also represented Debtor in various bankruptcy courts, in Chapter 7 and 13 matters, on these consumer debts by seeking relief from the §362 Automatic Stay, negotiating treatment in Chapter 13 plans, etc.
5. The professionals and paraprofessionals who have provided services to the estate pursuant to this application have been listed in the continuation to Attachment B to this application.
6. Counsel's efforts have resulted in the return of personal property securing loans to the Debtor, defense of the Debtor in state court actions and favorable treatment of the Debtor in Chapter 13 proceedings where it is a creditor.
7. This is Mapother and Mapother's First Interim and Final Fee Application.
8. Pursuant to Local Rule 2016-2(f), the undersigned certifies that he has reviewed the requirements of that Rule and believes this application complies with that Local Rule.
